Financial Reports.

The Board received copies of the **September 2022** Treasurer's and Cash Flow Reports. Chief Marrs stated that the reports show that everything is tracking well.

Chief's Report.

Chief Marrs reported on the following:

- Station Remodel Update Chief Marrs updated the Board and expressed his support for a package bid with separate funding sources. The Board agreed. Chief Marrs shared that asbestos was found in both Station 18 and 19 and a predemo cleaning will be done to address it. Commissioner Giba thanked Chief Marrs for quickly addressing this issue.
- Fire Benefit Charge (FBC) Update Chief Marrs asked the Board to schedule Special Meeting and Budget Public Hearing prior to November 15th. All Commissioners agreed to schedule the Special Meeting and Budget Public Hearing for Monday, November 14th, at 5 PM. Chief Marrs also mentioned that work is underway on the North Highline and District 2 budgets. One of the updates to the North Highline budget is to structure the budget items to mirror the District 2 budgeted items. The reason for this is to have the expenses reflected separately and to clearly define each expense type.

- AID 318 Upstaffing Chief Marrs discussed the Aid 318 upstaffing and that part of the budgeting process is exploring the costs of full-time staffing for Aid 318. Additional information will be forthcoming prior to the Budget Hearing.
- COVID Update Chief Marrs updated the Board on COVID and stated that Dr. Rea, Medical Director, is encouraging everyone to get the Bivalent vaccine and to prepare for another waive in the fall. Dr. Rae also encourages everyone to get their flu shot this season.
